NEGOTIATORS OF EUROPEAN COMMISSION AND UNITED KINGDOM REACH DEAL ON TERMS OF BREXIT WITHDRAWAL AGREEMENT

On 14 November 2018, the negotiators of the European Commission and the United Kingdom have reached a deal on the terms of the Brexit Withdrawal Agreement. All aspects of the Withdrawal Agreement have now been finalized and agreed at negotiator level. This agreement marks a decisive moment in the negotiations.

The Withdrawal Agreement covers all elements of the UK's withdrawal from the EU: citizens' rights, the financial settlement, a transition period, governance, Protocols on Ireland, Gibraltar and Cyprus, as well as a range of other separation issues.

We are aware of the fact that a lot of press releases on the Brexit topic have been circulated in the past few weeks. We would, however, like to draw your attention to a Fact Sheet published by the European Commission in which the content of the Withdrawal Agreement is explained in detail. In Section III of this document, there is a brief section that deals with "*minimizing disruption in distribution chains at the end of the transition period*" and which may be of direct relevance to you.
